Commonly asked questions on Miracle Disinfectant

Q. Is Miracle on the EPA and/or the CBC List?

A. Yes, it is on both lists as recommended for use against the Coronavirus.

Q. Is Miracle a Hospital grade disinfectant?

A. Yes, It is a broad spectrum disinfectant that kills Virus, Bacteria & Fungus.

- Q. How long does it take to kill viruses, bacteria and fungus with Miracle?
 A. Viruses are killed fastest, Norovirus in 30 seconds & Human
 Coronavirus 2 minutes but most bacteria in 3 minutes, TB in 5 minutes & fungus in 10 minutes.
- Q. Where can I see what Miracle kills?

A. It is listed on the bottle label & we have efficacy data sheets that show this information.

- Q. Is Miracle a cleaner too? A. Yes, you can actually clean, disinfect and deodorize with it.
- Q. Can I just spray & go with Miracle.

A. No, you do need to wipe clean the surface first in order to properly disinfect, but you can preclean with Miracle and then spray again to properly disinfect.

Q. What is dwell time?

A . How long the surface must stay wet to kill a specific organism. The longer the better of course. Refer to product Efficacy Date document for dwell times.

Q Is this disinfectant alcohol based?

A. No, alcohol is flammable which requires different licensing and it evaporates too quickly to actually neutralize the germs on surfaces.

Q. What size containers are available?

A. Miracle is sold in quarts & gallons.
